Arizona Desert's School Mission is to motivate and educate all students, to instill academic excellence, and to value education as a whole in a safe and secure environment.

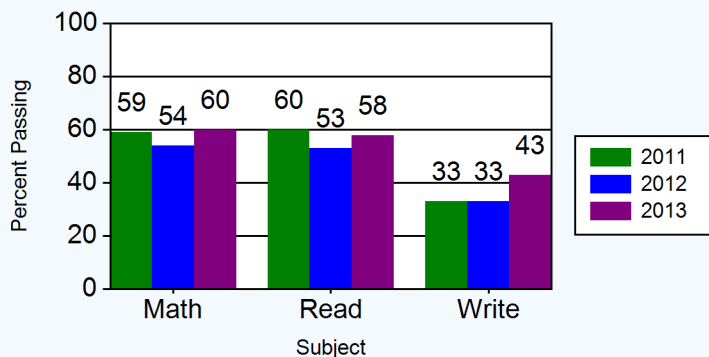

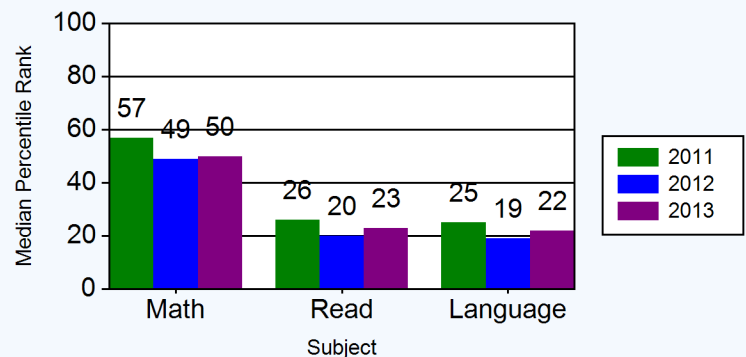
