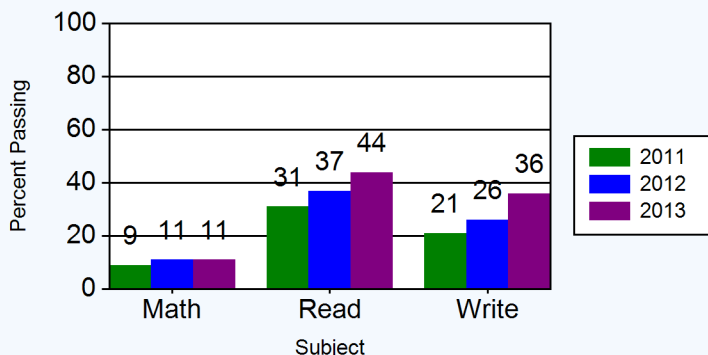
### School Mission and Goals

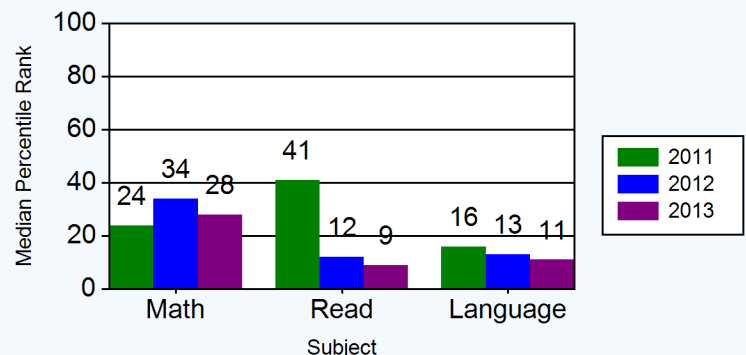
